  - **Split the Pot #2 la'dih** (Open Wednesday, November 10 at 12pm to Friday, November 19 at 5pm), tickets are \$20 each or 3 for \$50, 5 for \$75.
  - Tickets will be available for purchase until 5pm on the end date of each Split the Pot contest.
